

MOSCOW MILLS WOMAN PLEADS GUILTY IN OVERDOSE DEATH

TROY, Mo. – Lincoln County Prosecuting Attorney, Leah Wommack Askey, announced today that Wendy Voss, 32, of Moscow Mills, Missouri, plead guilty to involuntary manslaughter on February 3, 2014, for the heroin overdose death of Douglas Geiger, Jr., 29, of Moscow Mills.

Circuit Judge Chris Kunza Mennemeyer sentenced Voss to 7 years in prison for involuntary manslaughter and 10 years for distributing a controlled substance, sentences to be served concurrent.

Askey said she hoped Voss' sentence sent a message that she would not tolerate drug dealing in our community. "When lives are lost because of these dealers, I am even more passionate about sending offenders to prison. I want people to realize that drug overdoses happen in our county more frequently than imagined, and not all of those people are long time drug users or addicts," she said.
